DIRECTIONS

The clinic is located in the Cleveland Hearing and Speech Center, which is on the corner of Euclid Avenue and E. 117th Street.

From the North:

Exit at I-90 at Martin Luther King Blvd. Proceed south to Euclid Avenue. Turn left at Euclid. The building will be on the left at E. 117th.

From the South:

Take I-77 North or I-71 North (both become I-90 East) to the Chester Avenue exit. Proceed east on Chester to Euclid Avenue. Turn left on Fuclid.

From the East:

From the Ohio turnpike the suggested route is I-480 West to I-271 North. Exit at Cedar Road. Turn right on Coventry, then left on Mayfield. Veer right as Mayfield turns down into Little Italy. Turn right at Euclid Ave.

From the West:

Follow I-480 to I-71 North, or take I-90 East. Shortly past the merge of I-71 North - I-90 East, exit on Chester Avenue. Proceed east on Chester to Euclid Avenue. Turn left on Euclid Ave.

PARKING

Free parking is available behind the building on E. 117th St. Stop at the gate and use the air phone to call the front desk to gain access. If the lot is full, there are free 2-hour parking spots on E. 115th St. Street parking is also available along Euclid Ave. for up to an hour. Additionally, there is meter parking available in the outside lot directly across from Cleveland Hearing and Speech, on Euclid Ave.

Services are low-cost:

Therapy services are provided on a sliding fee scale based on income and family size and every effort is made to set an affordable fee.

Therapy Services:

Collaborative, goal-oriented, psychotherapy, including cognitive-behavioral therapy (CBT) for the following concerns:

- Depression, sadness, and loss
- Anxiety, worry, stress
- OCD and panic
- Coping with trauma
- Adjustment issues
- Relationship issues
- Parent-child relationships



Assessment Services:

Comprehensive assessments are provided to children (ages 6+), adolescents, and adults for:

- Learning Disorders
- ADHD
- Intellectual and achievement functioning
- Memory problems
- Cognitive problems
