EXPECTATIONS FOR CLINICAL PLACEMENT CWRU CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGY GRADUATE PROGRAM

INTERVENTION PLACEMENT

This is a 16-hour-per-week placement with a focus on developing skills in intervention. The student is expected to be at the site from the end of August through the end of May. This is a placement for a third or fourth year student. The student should have completed his/her Masters degree by September of their third year.

The number of therapy clients carried at any one time depends upon the setting and population. The student should see approximately 4-8 clients per week, on average. Based upon students' experience and comfort level, the supervisor can approve an increase in the number of clients.

Supervision should involve face-to-face meetings (in individual or group settings) with a licensed psychologist. There should be a minimum of one hour of supervision for every 8 hours of service by the student.

Students are expected to write treatment summaries and engage in the usual record keeping used at the site.

Students can also conduct intake interviews and psychological assessments as long as the focus is on intervention approaches.

In addition, the student should participate as much as possible in grand rounds, case conferences, and clinical meetings in the setting.

Supervisors will fill out student evaluations twice a year.
