## EXPECTATIONS FOR CLINICAL PLACEMENT CWRU CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGY GRADUATE PROGRAM

## ASSESSMENT PLACEMENT

This is an eight-hour-per-week placement with a focus on developing skills in psychological assessment. The student is expected to be at the site from the end of August through the end of May. This is a placement for a second year student. The student will have already completed a year-long course and practicum in intellectual and personality assessment in the first year of graduate school.

The expectation is that the student will complete 6 full batteries of both cognitive and personality assessment. The specific tests should be determined by the practicum site. The assessment can include interviewing and observation but should include administration, scoring and interpretation of psychological tests. Students are also expected to write psychological reports appropriate to the setting and to give assessment feedback to clients.

Supervision should involve face-to-face meetings (in individual or group settings) with a licensed psychologist. There should be a minimum of one hour of supervision for every 8 hours of service by the student.

In addition, the student should participate as much as possible in grand rounds, case conferences, and clinical meetings in the setting.

Supervisors will fill out student evaluations twice a year.
