CHC Director Spotlight: Kurt Koenigsberger

Dr. Kurt Koenigsberger has served as CHC Director since 2017. He is an Associate Dean in the College of Arts and Sciences at CWRU, which means he has responsibility for things like the CHC, remote and online learning, faculty-led study abroad courses, teacher licensure programs, and the College's alumni audit program. He has been a professor in the English Department at CWRU since 2000, and teaches courses in British literature since 1800, periodical literature around the turn of the century, British modernism, research methods, and steampunk lit. He has published a book on the British novel and its relation to collections of exotic animals from the 1850s to the 2000s. The CHC is the academic program with the most meaning and greatest impact he's been involved with in the past two decades!
