From Michelson to the Case Board of Trustees

Gentlemen,

I have been requested to furnish a statement giving a list of apparatus and appliances required for the use of the Department of Physics in the Case School, together with an estimate of the cost of the same – such estimates not to exceed the sum of thirty five hundred dollars (\$3500) that being the amount appropriated by your honorable body for the purpose.

The statement was prepared and duly approved and I was authorized to issue orders for the goods.

I would now respectfully request that the sum appropriated be placed in my hands to meet the bills as they come due.
