2023 Undergraduate Humanities Prize

The Humanities Prize recognizes a graduating humanities student for the writing of an exceptional research paper (usually a capstone project or senior thesis). The annual prize is typically awarded at the end of each Spring semester, with the recipient(s) receiving a \$500 cash stipend and participating in recognition ceremonies at both the Baker-Nord Center graduation celebration and the commencement awards assembly.

Eligibility: Only seniors graduating with a major in one of CWRU's humanities departments or interdisciplinary humanities program may apply. [Click here](#) for a list of eligible majors.

Application Components:

- i) Required: a completed cover sheet (this form)
- ii) Required: a copy of your best research paper (usually a capstone or senior thesis).
Please note that papers written in a foreign language should also include a two-page summary of the project written in English.
- iii) Recommended: A faculty letter of support that speaks to the quality and significance of your research paper. *Although not required for the 2023 competition, a letter from your major advisor or capstone professor is strongly encouraged. Recommenders should send their confidential letter directly to bakernord@case.edu.*
