APPLICATION MATERIALS

To apply, you must submit **ALL** of the following:

1) This Cover Sheet

2) A Personal Statement

We suggest following a simple five-paragraph model, which will cover all of the essentials while also describing your own interests and goals. Each of the five paragraphs should address, respectively:

- i. A short paragraph introducing yourself.
- ii. The basic details of the internship, including:
 - the title or role for which you have received an offer;
 - the name and city of the employer that you have received the offer from;
 - the start and end dates for the internship; and
 - the number of hours that will be worked per week.
- iii. The tasks and responsibilities that you will have as an intern, and the skills that you expect to learn in that role.
- iv. How your major, coursework, and/or extracurricular activities at CWRU have prepared you for this work experience.
- v. How the internship supports your post-graduation and career goals.

3) Your Resume

4) A Letter of Recommendation from your major advisor.

5) Unofficial Copy of Your CWRU Transcript

6) A copy of the offer letter from your employer, or a list of the internships to which you have applied.*

If you have not yet received a firm offer, you can still apply for funding. But you will have to provide a copy of the final offer letter prior to receiving the first disbursement of your stipend.

Eligibility

Grants are available only to students with demonstrated financial need who are pursuing a major in the humanities or social sciences within the College of Arts and Sciences at Case Western Reserve University. Preference will be given to underrepresented students.

Eligible majors are those associated with the departments of Anthropology, Art History and Art, Classics, Cognitive Science, Dance, English, History, Modern Languages and Literatures, Music, Philosophy, Political Science, Psychological Sciences, Religious Studies, Sociology, and Theater.
