

## English Major Requirements – Honors Track

### Total Hours: 36 hours (minimum)

To qualify for the B.A. with honors in English, students must achieve a minimum GPA of 3.75 in English courses taken for the honors track. Students wishing to follow this track should speak to their advisors as early in the major as possible. The honors program requires foreign-language competence at the 4th-semester level and 36 semester hours of coursework in English above the 100 level.
