Overall, in Fall 2007, our writing programs offered writing instruction and support in 92 courses comprising nearly 1430 students; in Spring 2008, the number was 71 courses serving nearly 1140 students. Over the course of the year, 52 writing instructors served nearly 2570 students.

27 of these instructors were English graduate TAs, 12 were full-time English lecturers (excluding those Lecturers teaching in SAGES or English 398 without other writing support), 4 were non-English graduate TAs, and 9 were part-time SAGES Lecturers.

ESL Writing Programs

In Fall 2007, our ESL programs served 62 undergraduate students (excluding supplemental writing instruction provided via the Writing Resource Center and ESL graduate students served in English 148 for non-undergraduates). 7 students enrolled in 1 section of English 148; 3 students enrolled in 1 section of ESL English 150; and 2 students enrolled in 5 sections of ESL First Seminar (1 section of Continuation from spring 2007; 1 section of single-semester ESL FSEM; 3 sections of "Stretch" FSEM). In Spring 2008, ESL programs served 48 undergraduate students. No section of English 148 was devoted specifically to ESL writers; a single section of ESL English 150 had 4 students; and 4 sections of FSEM Continuation comprised 44 students.

Overall, the English 148/150 program served 14 ESL students in 3 sections; SAGES served 96 students in 9 sections.
